To avoid seeing the BYOD connection prompt every time you plug in the USB-C cable, please disable this BYOD Connection Prompt feature in ZDM.







- 2. Tap Settings, then select Camera Control for Smart Connect Mode under "Camera Settings" section.
- 3. Adjust the camera positions as needed.



#### 1. What should I do if my laptop does not support usb-c?

You could use the USB-A and HDMI connecting the DTEN device with laptop .It's a another way to use BYOD

- 2. I use the USB-C for content share, but it does not work. Please check your computer spec if the USB-C port support Displayport Alt mode. The USB-C content share required the laptop to support Displayport Alt mode. Otherwise please use HDMI In for content share.
- 3. Can I use BYOD without a Zoom Room license or I didn't sign in the Zoom account? And how do I use it? You can still use BYOD even if you don't have a Zoom Room license. To connect your PC to the DTEN device, press the Menu Hard Key located in the back corner of the DTEN device, then select the Smart Connect button This will give you access to smart connect mode(which is the same feature as BYOD).
- 4. It takes many steps to get to BYOD on the Bar, why? Internal reference do not post Microsoft's definition of BYOD is different and MS is still defining what is MS BYOD. Currently, plug-n-play BYOD does not exist in MTR. Being able to allow our customers to still access Smart Connect is beyond-ready. We are exploring experience improvement under MS limitations and constraints In a later release, we may relocate the access to hot-swap pop-up or a button, but for now, the current access point is the set. We shall handle customer needs case-by-case and guide them to the admin settings menu.
- 5. Is there a longer USB-C cable I can use? Internal reference do not post

MS recommended <u>a solution</u> and it is compatible with all DTEN products (though it is not guaranteed compatible with your laptops, check with vendor).
